### About the Venue

Now this college is a constituent unit of Nanaji Deshmukh Veterinary Science University, Jabalpur established on 3<sup>rd</sup> November, 2009. The college campus is spread over 257 acres of land and is situated on Agra-Mumbai National Highway (NH 3), 4 km from Mhow cantonment and 18 km from the Indore city. It is well connected by road, rail and air; the nearest air port is Indore which is 25 km from college. Popular literature states that MHOW stands for Military Headquarters of War. In 2003, the town was renamed as Dr. Ambedkar Nagar in honour of Dr. B.R. Ambedkar who was born here. During the month of March, the temperature is pleasant during day time but mild cold during night.

## Theme

The livestock sector has emerged as an important stakeholder in GDP of nation in recent years. However, attempts to maximize the productivity of livestock obviously increase their vulnerability for diseases. It is therefore high time to adopt the sustainable scientific strategies that would help in maintaining sound health of animals during their entire productive life. ### Guidelines for Abstracts

The abstract should include the title of the paper (upper case), name(s) of the author(s) and location where the study was conducted. The abstract should be limited to 250-300 words, including objective of the study, brief description of the methodology used, summary of the results and conclusions. The abstract should be typed in MS Word, using Times New Roman font, 12 font size and in single space. The name of the presenting author should be underlined and his/her Email may also be mentioned to facilitate correspondence.

### Oral/Poster Presentation

The time allotted for invited lectures and oral presentations will be of 15 and 05 minutes, respectively followed by a discussion for 2 minutes. Facilities for LCD projector will be provided. Display boards will be provided for presentation of posters (Poster size: 3x4 feet).
