ICAR 10 days short course on "strategies for containment of antimicrobial resistance" from 13th to 22nd Nov. 2017 was organised by Dept. of Vety. Microbiology, College of Veterinary Science & Animal Husbandry, NDVSU, Jabalpur. The inauguration was held on 13th Nov. 2107. Dr. V. S. Tomar, Vice Chancellor, JNKVV, Jabalpur was the Chief Guest of the function and Dr. Dharmendra Verma, Director, State Forest Research Institute, Jabalpur was the Guest of Honour. Total 25 participants participated in the course. 17 Lectures were delivered by guests, dignitaries and faculty members.
